A-4232 Vainieri Huttle (D-37)

Establishes Apparel Procurement Board; sets standards for procurement of apparel by the State. (2008:S-3079)

A-4233 Vainieri Huttle (D-37)

Revises provisions of the "Senator Byron M. Baer Open Public Meetings Act" to ensure greater compliance. (2008:S-382; 2006:S-1292)

A-4234 Vainieri Huttle (D-37)

Requires government records to be made available on the Internet. (2008:S-305; 2006:A-4251)

A-4235 Vainieri Huttle (D-37)

Allows independent institutions of higher education to be eligible for NJ alternative fuel vehicle rebate and alternative fuel infrastructure programs. (2008:S-2207)

A-4236 Wagner (D-38); Conaway (D-7)

Requires chain restaurants to provide calorie information for food or beverage items offered for sale.

A-4237 Wagner (D-38); Johnson (D-37)

Requires collection of additional fee on request for certified copy of newborn's original birth record for support of certain activities by public cord blood bank.

A-4238 Wagner (D-38)

"Plastic Carryout Bag Reduction Act."

A-4239 Chiappone (D-31)

Establishes crime of using a defaced or stolen firearm to cause serious bodily or bodily injury to a

law enforcement officer; enhances penalties concerning defaced firearms.

A-4240 Burzichelli (D-3)

Concerns rights of DRPA employees. (2008:S-814; 2006:S-1798)

A-4241 Burzichelli (D-3)

Allows student who is eligible for special education programs and services for autism or other developmental disability to bring medically-recommended service dog to school. (2008:S-3103)

A-4242 Burzichelli (D-3)

Provides for licensure of elevator, escalator, and moving sidewalk contractors by State board. (2008:S-3102)

A-4243 Wagner (D-38)

Makes sundry changes to laws affecting organization and functions of MVC.

A-4244 Prieto (D-32)

Makes various changes to laws concerning motor vehicle equipment and inspections.

A-4245 Spencer (D-29); Schaer (D-36)

Revises approval process for rate changes applicable to medical malpractice liability insurance. (2008:S-2934)

A-4246 Schaer (D-36)

Makes supplemental appropriation of \$7,000,000 to DOE to reinstate nonpublic technology initiative aid.

A-4247 Wisniewski (D-19)

Permits municipalities to auction taxi licenses to highest bidder and requires taxicabs to post taxi license number and name of licensing municipalities on exterior.

A-4248 Wisniewski (D-19)

Prohibits SDA from restricting the ability of certain firms or persons from competing for contracts in more than one Division of Property Management and Construction classification or prequalification category. (2008:S-3092)

A-4249 Conners (D-7)

Recognizes POW and MIA as valid description of casualty status and category classification for military personnel.

A-4250 Conners (D-7); Tucker (D-28); O'Scanlon (R-12)

Allows DMVA to fundraise for handicap accessible vehicle purchase.

A-4251 Conners (D-7)

Requires DMVA, through State veterans service offices, to provide surviving beneficiary of deceased service member with comprehensive benefits packet. (2008:S-3082)

A-4252 Conners (D-7)

Establishes the "Veterans Court Pilot Program."

A-4253 Conners (D-7); Tucker (D-28); O'Scanlon (R-12)

Requires member of New Jersey National Guard to apply for all tuition benefits available through U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs in order to qualify for tuition-free enrollment at a public institution of higher education. (2008:S-3084)

A-4254 Rible (R-11); Johnson (D-37) +1

Requires local unit public employers to maintain and preserve retiree health benefits of PFRS retirees at least at the same level as provided at employee retirement. (2008:S-2986)

A-4255 Angelini (R-11); Rible (R-11)

Regulates assignment and use of vehicles owned or leased by State authorities.

A-4256 Angelini (R-11)

Requires NJ Commission on Science and Technology to establish a science and technology business assistance service. (2008:S-1395; 2006:A-4350)

A-4257 Addiego (R-8); Rudder (R-8)

Extends requirement of wastewater management planning agencies to establish or update wastewater management plans, and extends validity of sewer service areas and wastewater service areas, until April 7, 2011. (2008:S-2985)

A-4258 Rudder (R-8); Addiego (R-8)

Protects municipalities that have complied with affordable housing obligations from being required to provide more than their fair share.

A-4259 Giblin (D-34); Watson Coleman (D-15) +1

Allows application for PERS accidental disability benefit for injury sustained while employed at State psychiatric institution or correctional facility immediately prior to PERS membership. (2008:A-1891; 2006:S-2192)

A-4260 Gusciora (D-15); Vainieri Huttler (D-37)

Imposes certain conditions on NJPDES permit for energy generation facilities that withdraw water from, or discharge water to, a shallow lagoonal estuary. (2008:S-3041)

A-4261 Gusciora (D-15); Cryan (D-20) +1

Permits certain managers and deputy attorneys general of the State to negotiate collectively under the "New Jersey Employer-Employee Relations Act"; changes definition of managerial executive and removes confidential status of deputy attorneys general. (2008:S-3071)

A-4262 Quijano (D-20)

Authorizes negotiations with a bargaining representative of family child care providers.

A-4263 Quijano (D-20)

Authorizes negotiations with a bargaining representative of community care residential providers. (2008:S-3080)

A-4264 Quijano (D-20)

Revises statutes concerning permissible length of time between certain public questions in certain municipalities.

A-4265 McKeon (D-27)

Provides for covenant not to sue by operation of law upon issuance of no further action letter in certain circumstances relating to site remediations. (2008:S-3040)

A-4266 McKeon (D-27)

Regulates sale of olive oil.

A-4267 Cryan (D-20)

Increases reimbursement rate for certain special education costs. (2008:S-3030)

A-4268 Cryan (D-20); Quijano (D-20)

Extends prevailing wage requirements to certain maintenance-related projects. (2008:S-3095)

A-4269 Quijano (D-20)

Permits municipal or county Hispanic advisory commission to have more than five members.

A-4270 Jasey (D-27)

Establishes New Jersey Special Education and Traumatic Brain Injury Task Force. (2008:S-3036)

A-4271 McKeon (D-27)

Requires Governor to make temporary appointment when vacancy occurs in U.S. Senate; requires appointee be member of same political party as person vacating office since beginning of that term; eliminates special election option.

A-4272 Johnson (D-37)

Permits certain urban police training schools that train at least one class of recruits annually to continue operating. (2008:S-2824)

A-4273 Amodeo (R-2); Polistina (R-2)

Provides gross income tax exclusion for income earned in aviation related employment during or

after qualified aviation related job training.

A-4274 Polistina (R-2); Amodeo (R-2)

Authorizes county colleges and county vocational school districts to establish aviation related job certification, training, and internship programs and provides a corporation business tax credit for funds donated to support such programs.

A-4275 Polistina (R-2); Amodeo (R-2)

Establishes innovation zone program and creates innovation zone around Aviation Research and Technology Park in Atlantic County.

A-4276 Polistina (R-2); Amodeo (R-2)

Reduces from ten to three number of qualified voters in an election for whom a person can serve as an authorized messenger.

A-4277 Polistina (R-2); Amodeo (R-2)

Addresses qualifications and compensation of casino conservators and persons providing services under conservatorship.

A-4278 Greenwald (D-6)

Establishes a New Jersey Homebuyer Tax Credit Program under the New Jersey gross income tax for home purchases during calendar year 2010. (2008:S-3066)

A-4279 Cryan (D-20)

Establishes in DOE a four-year Community Service Phase Two Pilot Enhancement Program. (2008:S-2898)

A-4280 Green (D-22); Scalera (D-36)

Modifies rule governing decisions under the "Municipal Land Use Law;" requires economic impact analysis by EDA. (2008:S-3045; 2006:A-3870)

A-4281 Green (D-22)

Authorizes providing police director in certain cities with duties and powers of police chief under certain circumstances.

A-4282 Wisniewski (D-19)

Makes various changes to State law concerning commercial driver licenses to comply with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. (2008:S-3091)

A-4283 Wisniewski (D-19)

Makes various changes to current system for approval, issuance, administration, and discontinuance of various types of special license plates.

A-4284 Wisniewski (D-19)

Permits NJTA to undertake design-build procurements.

A-4285 Barnes (D-18) +1

Requires correctional facilities to provide inmates with prescription medication that was prescribed for chronic conditions existing prior to incarceration.

A-4286 Barnes (D-18); Ramos (D-33) +2

Provides for spend-down eligibility category for Senior Gold Prescription Discount Program.

A-4287 Barnes (D-18); Ramos (D-33) +3

Requires certain DOC, county and municipal prison physicians to acquire certain training.

A-4288 Burzichelli (D-3)

Establishes procedures and standards regarding public service privatization contracts.

A-4289 Egan (D-17); Evans (D-35)

Provides for annual adjustments in family temporary disability leave contribution rates and limits certain refunds of contributions. (2008:S-3065)

A-4290 DeAngelo (D-14)

Revises the definition of "public works projects" related to project labor agreements to include

bridges.

A-4291 DeAngelo (D-14)

Extends prevailing wage requirements to certain non-rental multi-family housing projects. (2008:S-3096)

A-4292 DeAngelo (D-14)

Permits construction workers to file a lien against the owner of real property under "Construction Lien Law."

A-4293 DeAngelo (D-14)

Concerns payment of prevailing wage in certain construction undertaken with BPU financial assistance. (2008:S-3028)

A-4294 Oliver (D-34)

Extends workers' compensation surviving spouse lump sum to remarriages occurring after the 450th week of benefits.

A-4295 Moriarty (D-4); Albano (D-1); Ramos (D-33) +5

Prohibits certain unsolicited checks. (2008:S-3046)

A-4296 Stender (D-22); Vainieri Huttle (D-37)

Prohibits the enforcement of "palimony" agreements unless such agreements are in writing. (2008:S-2091; 2006:A-2796)

A-4297 Burzichelli (D-3)

Makes membership in the New Jersey School Boards Association optional.

A-4298 Watson Coleman (D-15)

Requires State entities to examine opportunity of minority and women-owned financial institutions to serve as senior managing underwriters, imposes reporting requirements, and enables establishment of aspirational levels of utilization and relative compen (2008:S-2846)

A-4299 Watson Coleman (D-15)

Creates Foreclosure Prevention and Neighborhood Stabilization Revolving Trust Fund; places temporary surcharge on mortgage foreclosure complaints.

A-4300 Quigley (D-32); Schaer (D-36); Conners (D-7)

Expedites payment of PFRS accidental death benefit. (2008:S-3072)

A-4301 Johnson (D-37)

Brings State law into conformity with federal law concerning sharing of certain mental health information relating to the purchase and possession of firearms. (2008:S-3076)

A-4302 McKeon (D-27)

Increases penalties for loaning motor vehicle to person with suspended driver's license in certain circumstances. (2008:S-2940)

A-4303 McKeon (D-27)

Provides that certain drunk driving offenders who drive with a suspended driver's license are guilty of a fourth degree crime. (2008:S-2939)

A-4304 Burzichelli (D-3); Johnson (D-37)

Clarifies that certain transfers of handguns are not subject to law prohibiting purchase of more than one handgun in a 30-day period. (2008:S-3068)

A-4305 DeAngelo (D-14)

Concerns apprenticeship programs and other standards for public works contractors. (2008:S-3094)

A-4306 McKeon (D-27)

Requires mandatory jail time for certain driving while intoxicated convictions with high blood alcohol concentration. (2008:S-2937)

* A-4309 Chiusano (R-24); Rudder (R-8); Addiego (R-8)

Appropriates \$17.45 million in 1992 and 2003 bond act monies for loans to fund dam restoration projects. (2008:S-3042)

* A-4310 Dancer (R-30)

Provides for electronic monitoring of domestic violence offenders and notification to the victim; designated as "Lisa's Law."

* A-4311 Conners (D-7)

Grants credit against business taxes to developer of rental housing reserved for occupancy by veterans. (2008:S-2994)

* A-4312 Conners (D-7)

The "Debt-Management Services Act of New Jersey."

* A-4313 Scalera (D-36)

Revises procedure for reassessment of certain real property by assessor and appeal of assessment by certain property taxpayers. (2008:S-2711)

* A-4314 Johnson (D-37)

Permits a child whose parent or guardian is ordered into active military service to remain enrolled in the school district where the child's parent or guardian resided prior to active military service.

* A-4315 Johnson (D-37)

Extends time period during which municipal fire departments may hire certain laid off firefighters.

* A-4316 Jasey (D-27)

Redirects appropriations in "Mortgage Stabilization and Relief Act" (2009) to provide more effective foreclosure relief to homeowners. (2008:S-3067)

* A-4317 Casagrande (R-12)

Provides State Comptroller with express authority to engage certified public accountants as independent contractors on contingency fee basis.

* A-4318 Wisniewski (D-19)

Permits wage withholding for costs associated with certain employee identification.

* A-4319 Diegnan (D-18)

Revises the "Construction Lien Law."

* A-4320 Diegnan (D-18)

Requires State Treasurer to follow usual procurement process prior to entering into cooperative purchasing agreements.

* A-4321 Diegnan (D-18)

Grants immunity to court-appointed psychologists and psychiatrists in certain family court matters.

* A-4322 Watson Coleman (D-15)

Revises organization and powers of Capital City Redevelopment Corporation.

* A-4323 Watson Coleman (D-15)

Establishes standards and requirements set forth in Executive Order No. 151 (2009) for use of funds from American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. (2008:S-3107)

* A-4324 Lampitt (D-6)

Permits undersheriff to perform administrative duties on behalf of county sheriff. (2008:S-2556)

* A-4325 Lampitt (D-6)

"New Jersey Basic Skills Training Program for Economic Growth Act."

* A-4326 Wisniewski (D-19)

Limits use of inherently beneficial use doctrine when municipality making variance determination has received substantive certification from the Council on Affordable Housing; provides repose from litigation.

* A-4327 Lampitt (D-6)

Establishes NJ PLACE program to facilitate college credit for registered apprenticeship programs. (2008:S-3093)

ACR-244 Polistina (R-2); Amodeo (R-2)

Urges Governor to declare aviation a critical industry of NJ and make available NJ government resources to promote and assist development of aviation in NJ.

* AJR-130 Greenwald (D-6); Lampitt (D-6)

Designates third week in January of each year as "Childhood Cancer Awareness Week."

AR-213 Conners (D-7)

Urges Department of Defense to reinstate the POW/MIA designation.

AR-214 Amodeo (R-2); Polistina (R-2)

Requests Commissioner of Transportation to designate current departmental employee as "NextGen Liaison."

AR-215 Rible (R-11)

Opposes federal six-month ban on black sea bass fishing. (2008:SR-136)

AR-216 Carroll (R-25)

Urges reduction of bluefin tuna fishing.

AR-217 Carroll (R-25)

Urges Congress to pass "Surface Transportation and Taxation Equity Act."
