A-2362 Johnson (D-37)

The "Animal Cruelty Recodification and Modernization Act."

A-2363 Cryan (D-20)

Makes it unlawful practice to sell certain products via Internet auction. (2006:A-3866)

A-2364 Cohen (D-20)

Requires criminal background check for name change and prohibits persons convicted of certain crimes from changing their name. (2006:A-3052; 2004:A-4515)

A-2365 Cohen (D-20)

Permits certain retired justices and judges to retain special license plates. (2006:A-3051; 2004:A-1969)

A-2366 Cohen (D-20)

Imposes liability insurance requirement on alcoholic beverage licensees and provides penalties for occupancy and fire code violations. (2006:A-3047; 2004:A-1814)

A-2367 Cohen (D-20)

Authorizes special American Legion license plates for motorcycles. (2006:A-3606)

A-2368 Cohen (D-20)

Establishes special license plates for veterans. (2006:A-3050; 2004:A-1968)

A-2369 Cohen (D-20)

Authorizes reimbursement for EMT training from EMT Training Fund for certain volunteer firefighters. (2006:A-4095)

A-2370 Cohen (D-20)

Grants immunity from civil liability to persons who give good faith report of terroristic activity or threats. (2006:A-290; 2004:A-1847)

A-2371 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits false or secret compartments in motor vehicles under certain circumstances. (2006:A-2927; 2004:A-4585)

A-2372 Cohen (D-20)

Provides for increased penalties for a crime committed in a church, synagogue, temple or other place of public worship. (2006:A-2517; 2004:A-748)

A-2373 McKeon (D-27); Malone (R-30)

Permits municipalities to set strict absentee policies for service on authorities, boards and commissions and requires certain appointees to receive ethics training.

A-2374 Greenstein (D-14)

Requires scooter riders under 14 years old to wear helmets. (2006:A-1806; 2004:A-810)

A-2375 Bramnick (R-21)

Requires ballot question on approval of State bond issue to disclose total amount of debt of State or other entity, debt service on which is funded through annual State appropriation. (2008:S-403; 2006:S-710)

A-2376 Bramnick (R-21)

Allows charitable contribution tax deductions under New Jersey gross income tax. (2008:S-298; 2006:S-2721)

A-2377 Bramnick (R-21); Rumana (R-40)

Makes desecration of a military monument a crime of the third degree. (2008:S-290; 2006:S-1863)

A-2378 Bramnick (R-21)

Establishes procedures for approval of certain applications for development affecting neighboring municipalities. (2008:S-286; 2006:S-714)

A-2379 Bramnick (R-21); Moriarty (D-4)

Provides sales and use tax exemption for new motor vehicles with certain fuel efficiency. (2008:S-292; 2006:S-1938)

A-2380 Bramnick (R-21)

The "New Jersey Senior Citizen Taxpayer Reverse Mortgage Program." (2008:S-681; 2006:A-2942)

A-2381 Bramnick (R-21)

Creates the "Local Unit Audit Teams" program in the Department of the Treasury.
(2008:S-678; 2006:A-2880)

A-2382 Handlin (R-13)

Authorizes Commissioner of Transportation to extend current ban on large trucks outside of National Network to 96-inch wide trucks. (2006:A-4197; 2004:S-1357)

A-2383 Rudder (R-8); Addiego (R-8)

Permits advertising on exterior of school buses. (2006:S-2116)

A-2384

Permanently disqualifies certain persons convicted of child endangerment from working with children. (2008:S-52; 2006:S-442)

A-2385 Diegnan (D-18)

Limits service of poll worker who is elected official or candidate for elective office.
(2006:A-3568)

A-2386 Diegnan (D-18)

Allows the New Jersey Educational Facilities Authority to finance working capital loans for institutions of higher education, revenue-generating projects through institution affiliates, and projects of out-of-state institutions benefiting New Jersey students (2008:S-303; 2006:A-3677)

A-2387 McHose (R-24); Chiusano (R-24)

Clarifies provisions of law concerning commissions and buyer's premiums for sale of local government real estate. (2008:S-506)

A-2388 McHose (R-24); Chiusano (R-24)

Requires minimum geographic cost adjustment for school districts in certain counties.

A-2389 Diegnan (D-18)

Allows campaign finance reports to be filed with county clerk for certain candidates. (2006:A-4588)

A-2390 Diegnan (D-18)

Requires theaters to reserve certain seats for patrons with hearing loss. (2006:A-3126)

A-2391 Diegnan (D-18)

Authorizes COAH to credit municipalities' fair share affordable housing obligations with certain housing units occupied by employees of a State or regional cultural center located within 3,000 feet of the housing units. (2006:A-4005)

A-2392 Diegnan (D-18)

Permits municipal utilities to earn 10 percent profit for use as municipal property tax relief. (2006:A-3379)

A-2393 Diegnan (D-18)

Permits candidates for school employment and school bus drivers to demonstrate rehabilitation to the Commissioner of Education to avoid disqualification due to a criminal conviction revealed in a criminal history record check. (2006:A-4193)

A-2394 Diegnan (D-18)

Directs school nurse to develop individual health care plan for students with diabetes and allows certain diabetic students to test blood and administer insulin in the classroom. (2006:A-2403)

A-2395 Diegnan (D-18); Barnes (D-18) +1

Requires the placement of defibrillators in public use airports. (2006:A-2401)

A-2396 Diegnan (D-18); Egan (D-17)

Requires hearing loss sensitivity training for public school pupils and teaching staff members. (2006:A-2402)

A-2397 Diegnan (D-18); Egan (D-17) +4

Expands the Tuition Aid Grant program to part-time undergraduates. (2006:A-858; 2004:A-1250)

A-2398 Diegnan (D-18); Egan (D-17) +4

Prohibits registration of identical or similar corporate alternate names.

A-2399 Casagrande (R-12)

Establishes NJ Task Force on Records Privacy. (2006:A-2105)

A-2401 Casagrande (R-12)

Prohibits payment of temporary disability benefits to incarcerated individuals. (2006:A-2565; 2004:S-2327)

A-2402 Diegnan (D-18); Egan (D-17) +5

Requires health insurance carriers to use standard explanation of benefits form. (2006:A-1208; 2004:A-3719)

A-2403 Merkt (R-25); Carroll (R-25)

Repeals law requiring prenotification of certain plant closings, transfers and mass layoffs.

A-2404 Merkt (R-25)

Requires impact statement for any proposed regulation affecting volunteer ambulance squads and fire companies. (2006:A-199; 2004:A-243)

A-2405 Merkt (R-25)

Allows for certain variances, exemptions, and waivers under "Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act." (2008:S-822; 2006:S-242)

A-2406 Cohen (D-20)

Clarifies obligation of cemeteries to hold consumer prepayments for cemetery services in trust accounts. (2006:A-3088; 2004:A-2776)

A-2407 Giblin (D-34)

Provides for the establishment of fiscal management and accountability standards at public research universities and State colleges.

A-2408 Cohen (D-20)

Consolidates individual and small employer health benefits programs under one board. (2006:A-3599)

A-2409 Cohen (D-20)

Requires general hospitals to submit certain financial data to DHSS concerning third party payments for services rendered. (2006:A-4128)

* A-2411 Wisniewski (D-19)

Authorizes creation and operation of stormwater utility systems. (2008:S-1166)

* A-2412 Wisniewski (D-19)

Extends from 14 days to 60 days length of permitted adjournments of sale of real property by sheriff or other officer selling real estate by virtue of an execution.

* A-2413 Doherty (R-23)

Eliminates separate presidential primary election; provides delegates and alternates to national conventions of political parties will be elected at regular June primary election.

* A-2414 Karrow (R-23)

Establishes special motorcycle license plates for veterans.

* A-2415 Karrow (R-23)

Requires trucks to have governors set at 68 miles per hour. (2006:A-3120)

* A-2416 Dancer (R-30)

Authorizes "Severely Disabled Veteran" license plates for qualified veterans; entitle holders to handicapped parking privileges. (2006:S-2959)

* A-2417 Cohen (D-20); Karrow (R-23)

Requires accountability of NJSPCA and county societies for the prevention of cruelty to animals to Attorney General and county prosecutors, respectively.

* A-2418 Cohen (D-20); Karrow (R-23)

Changes membership of, and election process for, NJSPCA board of trustees.

* A-2419 Cohen (D-20)

Exempts certain professionals from liability for advice rendered in relation to classification of construction employees. (2006:A-4117)

* A-2420 Cohen (D-20)

Establishes the Criminal Code Review Commission. (2006:A-4530)

* A-2421 Cohen (D-20)

Clarifies that the definition of "racketeering activity" in the RICO statute includes securities fraud offenses. (2006:A-3587; 2004:A-3228)

* A-2422 Cohen (D-20)

Creates six additional Tax Court judgeships. (2006:A-4535)

* A-2423 Cohen (D-20)

Creates "New Jersey Catastrophic Health Care Claims Reinsurance Program." (2006:A-3366; 2004:A-4264)

* A-2424 Cohen (D-20)

Requires insurers to provide coverage for medications and dose-intensive chemotherapy/bone marrow transplants and umbilical cord blood transplants for treatment of sickle cell anemia. (2006:A-3041)

* A-2425 Cohen (D-20)

Revises certain provisions of "Insurance Premium Finance Company Act." (2006:A-3712)

* A-2426 Prieto (D-32); Wisniewski (D-19)

Prohibits purchaser of used motor vehicle from waiving dealer's obligation regarding emissions control equipment. (2008:S-516; 2006:S-380)

* A-2427 Prieto (D-32); Wisniewski (D-19)

Concerns lost or stolen E-ZPass transponders. (2008:S-515; 2006:S-379)

* A-2428 Pou (D-35)

Amends Health Enterprise Zone law to allow municipalities more discretion in granting property tax exemptions to medical offices. (2008:S-544; 2006:S-3045)

* A-2429 Munoz (R-21)

Requires OLS to make audiovisual recordings of legislative sessions available to public in electronic form. (2006:A-2388; 2004:A-3497)

* A-2430 Connors (D-7)

Allows military personnel extended period to qualify for exclusion of capital gain from income of the sale or exchange of a principal residence. (2006:A-212; 2004:A-2208)

* A-2431 Conaway (D-7)

Provides for tattoo pigment labeling requirements.

* A-2432 Conaway (D-7)

Requires carriers offering managed care plans to report certain utilization management decisions to DOBI.

* A-2433 Conaway (D-7)

"Tattooing and Body Piercing Practice Act." (2006:A-542; 2004:A-1317)

* A-2434 Burzichelli (D-3)

Expands covered claims under New Jersey Surplus Lines Insurance Guaranty Fund to include liquor law liability insurance claims. (2006:A-1923; 2004:A-4218)

* A-2435 Casagrande (R-12)

Requires State Treasurer to post information about State contracts for \$17,500 or more on special website. (2006:A-1179; 2004:A-2521)

* A-2436 Casagrande (R-12)

Extends textbook sharing program to include all school equipment. (2008:S-676; 2006:A-1678)

* A-2437 McKeon (D-27); Greenstein (D-14)

Establishes special environmental prosecutor. (2006:A-1861; 2004:A-1289)

* A-2438 McKeon (D-27)

Increases cap for underground storage tank remediation grants to independent colleges. (2008:S-717; 2006:S-2964)

* A-2439 Chivukula (D-17)

Directs BPU to require companies under its jurisdiction to bill customers electronically upon customers' request.

* A-2440 Pou (D-35)

Permits qualified trustee to hold interest in alcoholic beverage license for qualified beneficiary under age 18. (2008:S-656; 2006:S-2867)

* A-2441 Johnson (D-37)

Revises deadline for selection of delegates for annual convention of New Jersey State Firemen's Association. (2006:A-4615)

* A-2442 Cryan (D-20)

Requires certification and establishes registry in DHS of community agency employees working with persons with developmental disabilities. (2008:S-1379)

* A-2443 Greenstein (D-14)

Requires the placement of defibrillators in public school buildings. (2006:A-708; 2004:A-2973)

* A-2444 Greenstein (D-14)

Requires institutions of higher education to provide students with access to mental health care programs and services and to establish a hotline to provide information concerning the availability of those services. (2006:A-4462)

* A-2445 Quigley (D-32); Spencer (D-29)

Requires county board of elections to notify voters about procedure for changing political party affiliation before any primary election; changes date for publication of notice.

* A-2446 Amodeo (R-2)

Makes elected officials with compensation less than \$50,000 ineligible for health care benefits on the 61st day after enactment.

* A-2447 Webber (R-26); Quigley (D-32); Schaer (D-36)

Prohibits legislative aide who works, or worked, directly for legislator in district office from making political contribution to that legislator.

* A-2448 McKeon (D-27)

Requires financial institution to notify account holder when information relative to an electronic fund transfer is shared with third party. (2006:A-1869; 2004:A-1831)

* A-2449 Wagner (D-38)

Regulates expiration dates and dormancy fees for certain prepaid bank cards, such as mall gift cards. (2008:S-612; 2006:S-1249)

* A-2450 Chiusano (R-24)

Enhances duty and broadens liability concerning security of personal information, and response to breach of security, under "Identity Theft Prevention Act."

ACR-152 Bramnick (R-21); Addiego (R-8)

Requires that annual State appropriations bill lay over for seven days before final passage unless passed by three-fourths majority vote. (2008:SCR-35; 2006:SCR-28)

ACR-153 Bramnick (R-21)

Amends Constitution to prohibit constitutionally dedicated open space, farmland, and historic preservation funds from being used to pay for associated State agency administrative costs. (2008:SCR-43; 2006:SCR-36)

ACR-154 Merkt (R-25); Karrow (R-23)

Proposes amendment to State Constitution to provide that general appropriation law will continue in effect until new such law is enacted. (2006:ACR-203)

* ACR-157 Rudder (R-8); Addiego (R-8)

Proposes constitutional amendment requiring that solar farms not less than 5 acres in size shall receive farmland assessment treatment.

* ACR-158 Greenstein (D-14)

Memorializes Congress to enact legislation banning phthalates and bisphenol A in food containers, toys, and child care articles.

* AJR-83 Prieto (D-32); Wisniewski (D-19)

Designates May 24th as "Aviation Maintenance Technician Day." (2008:SJR-15; 2006:SJR-43)

* AR-109 Rible (R-11); Angelini (R-11)

Urges Congress to approve and President to sign into law "Flexibility in Rebuilding American Fisheries Act of 2008."
