Requires pharmacists to notify consumers when prescribed medications are substituted with generic drugs. (2008:S-906)

A-2031 Dancer (R-30); Cohen (D-20)

Expands Catastrophic Illness in Children Relief Fund Commission purpose to provide assistance for purchase of specialized vehicle to transport person over 21 years old with severe chronic disability.

A-2058 Burzichelli (D-3)

Provides surviving spouses of certain fire and police personnel who die in line of duty with workers' compensation for entire period of survivorship. (2008:S-668; 2006:S-2351)

Clarifies functions of land surveyor as distinguished from functions of licensed professional engineer. (2006:A-4066; 2004:A-2897)

A-2060 McKeon (D-27)

Requires small school districts to share superintendents and school business administrators under certain circumstances. (2006:A-1867; 2004:A-1314)

A-2061 McKeon (D-27)

Provides for State assumption of the costs of the county prosecutors' offices. (2008:S-740; 2006:A-2302; 2004:A-1304)

A-2062 McKeon (D-27)

Reestablishes senior citizen supplemental stabilization aid.
