A-1783 Milam (D-1)

Increases PFRS benefits for active members when PFRS funded at 101%, for retirees over three fiscal years thereafter. (2006:A-2630; 2004:A-3853)

A-1784 Milam (D-1)

Requires that any United States or State of New Jersey flag purchased with State funds be manufactured in the United States. (2006:A-2939)

A-1785 Milam (D-1)

Provides enhanced benefits to survivors of certain PFRS members. (2006:A-2629; 2004:A-415)

A-1786 Milam (D-1)

Provides paid post-retirement medical benefits to certain retired veteran State employees. (2006:A-2474; 2004:A-3081)

A-1787 Milam (D-1)

Permits exclusion from calculation of adjusted municipal tax levy of increases greater than four percent in amounts required to be raised for emergency service purposes. (2006:A-4243)

A-1788 Milam (D-1)

Provides that only certain DOC employees may recruit, interview, and hire corrections officers. (2006:A-4203)

A-1789 Milam (D-1)

Requires Commissioner of Corrections to institute 15-minute shift overlap in State correctional facilities. (2006:A-4202)

A-1790 Milam (D-1)

Requires civilian employees of DOC to be trained in gang awareness. (2006:A-4204)

A-1791 Milam (D-1)

Requires 40 hours annual in-service training for State corrections officers. (2006:A-4201)

A-1792 Albano (D-1)

Establishes the New Jersey Task Force on Domestic Violence and Abuse. (2008:S-993; 2006:A-2908)

A-1793 Milam (D-1)

Requires internal affairs investigations to be conducted by unit separate from unit

responsible for collecting gang intelligence information. (2006:A-4206)

A-1794 Conners (D-7)

Increases certain fees concerning court officers. (2006:A-3627)

A-1795 Milam (D-1)

Requires State Auditor review of certain Department of Corrections privatization contracts. (2006:A-2168; 2004:A-3304)

A-1796 Albano (D-1)

Revises statutes concerning abandoned vessels to include sunken vessels; authorizes municipalities to remove abandoned vessels from municipal waterways. (2006:A-3767)

A-1797 Albano (D-1)

Provides credit against gross income tax for first time home buyers with household incomes less than \$100,000. (2006:A-2843; 2004:A-2832)

A-1798 Milam (D-1)

Requires home interview of corrections officer applicants. (2006:A-4205)

A-1799 Albano (D-1)

"New Jersey Fair Market Drug Pricing Act"; establishes New Jersey Rx Card Program to reduce prescription drug prices. (2006:A-1032; 2004:A-2315)

A-1801 Milam (D-1)

A-1803 Albano (D-1)

"Pharmacy Quality Improvement and Error Prevention Act." (2006:A-1025; 2004:A-398)

A-1804 Karrow (R-23)

Specifies allocation of moneys from "2007 Blue Acres Fund" for Delaware River.

A-1805 Johnson (D-37)

Requires builders registering under "New Home Warranty and Builders' Registration Act" to provide Social Security and employer identification numbers. (2006:A-3211)

A-1806 Milam (D-1)

Establishes certain customer protection requirements for cable television customers. (2006:A-2712; 2004:A-397)

A-1807 Milam (D-1)

Establishes the Travel and Tourism Supplemental Revenue Fund. (2006:A-1031; 2004:A-1934)

A-1808 Milam (D-1)

Authorizes DEP and NJ Marine Fisheries Council to regulate taking and management of striped bass. (2006:A-3754)

A-1810 Milam (D-1)

Regulates telephone customer service practices. (2006:A-2089; 2004:A-408)

A-1811 Albano (D-1)

Requires adult Work First New Jersey recipients to complete secondary education under certain circumstances and receive life skills training. (2006:A-2572; 2004:S-611)

A-1812 Milam (D-1)

Creates a directory of registered telemarketers. (2006:A-2713; 2004:A-3852)

A-1813 Milam (D-1)

Supplemental appropriation of \$2 million to NJ Commerce and Economic Growth Commission for tourism promotion and grants to regional tourism councils. (2006:A-2475; 2004:A-390)

A-1814 Albano (D-1)

Requires notice to primary and secondary borrower before repossession of motor vehicle under certain circumstances. (2006:A-3124)

A-1815 Milam (D-1)

Suspends certain tolls during evacuation of coastal areas. (2006:A-2933; 2004:A-4503)

A-1816 Milam (D-1)

Prohibits telecommunications, utility or cable television companies from charging certain customers prior to actual billing due date. (2006:A-2567; 2004:A-3703)

A-1817 Cohen (D-20)

Establishes Office of Airline Consumer Advocate and consumer bill of rights for airline passengers; requires provision of certain services to passengers on flights delayed more than two hours.

Requires State to contract with pharmaceutical companies to purchase influenza vaccine for high-risk persons and their care providers. (2006:A-756; 2004:A-3550)

A-1819 Cohen (D-20)

"Distressed Cemetery Maintenance and Preservation Act." (2006:A-2973)

A-1820 Milam (D-1)

Requires telemarketers to have signed consent form or written request before making telemarketing sales calls to customer on NJ Do Not Call List. (2006:A-2165; 2004:A-2290)

A-1821 Cohen (D-20); Bramnick (R-21)

Reforms the review, processing, and payment of certain private passenger automobile insurance personal injury protection claims. (2006:A-3703)

A-1822 Merkt (R-25)

Restores the death penalty.

A-1823 Milam (D-1)

Eliminates certain components of realty transfer fee. (2006:A-1045; 2004:A-3485)

A-1824 Cohen (D-20)

Revises qualifications for licensure for land surveyors and for certificates of registration for surveyors-in-training. (2006:A-3753)

A-1825 Cohen (D-20)

Allows members of PERS Prosecutors Part to establish purchased PERS credit in the Part at additional cost. (2006:A-3722)

A-1826 Milam (D-1)

Establishes "New Jersey Veterans' Hospital Task Force." (2006:A-1057; 2004:A-4453)

A-1827 Cohen (D-20)

Requires certain Internet operators to remove defamatory materials and to disclose account information to defamed individuals. (2006:A-2623; 2004:A-2029)

A-1828 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits sale of any dog by kennel, pet shop or other retail establishment without name, address and phone number of person providing dog thereto; establishes \$500 fine for each violation. (2006:A-3238; 2004:S-301)

A-1829 Johnson (D-37)

Revises law governing compulsory arbitration for public fire and police departments. (2006:S-2626)

A-1830 Cohen (D-20)

Requires offering homeowners and private passenger automobile insurance policies under certain circumstances.

A-1831 Conaway (D-7)

Requires county prosecutors to investigate credible allegations of voter intimidation; requires Attorney General to direct investigation if county prosecutor fails to act.

A-1832 Johnson (D-37)

Provides for voluntary contributions by taxpayers on gross income tax returns for New Jersey National Guard members and their families in need of assistance. (2008:S-1021; 2006:A-4123; 2004:A-3838)

Establishes a civil action for the eviction or removal of persons who commit drug-related crimes on leased residential property. (2006:A-1623; 2004:A-2402)

A-1834 Conaway (D-7)

Establishes the reckless discharge of a firearm as a crime of the fourth degree. (2006:A-1609; 2004:A-1497)

A-1835 Johnson (D-37)

Permits immediate expungement of court records where the person is acquitted or discharged or where the charges have been dismissed. (2006:A-779; 2004:A-1444)

A-1836 Conaway (D-7)

Modifies blood alcohol concentration level for drunk driving conviction for repeat offender. (2006:A-1608; 2004:A-1496)

A-1837 Conaway (D-7)

Authorizes leave for parents and guardians of children with special needs. (2006:A-1607; 2004:S-440)

A-1838 Conaway (D-7)

Extends prevailing wage requirements to projects of county bridge commissions. (2006:A-3026; 2004:A-4574)

A-1839 Conaway (D-7)

Prohibits sale of mercury batteries and consumer products that use mercury batteries; prohibits disposal of used mercury batteries as solid waste. (2006:A-3485)

A-1840 Conaway (D-7)

Expands eligibility for subsidy payments from CATV Universal Access Fund to include certain Medicaid recipients. (2006:A-3629)

A-1841 Johnson (D-37)

The "New Jersey Spam Deterrence Act." (2006:A-217; 2004:A-3393)

A-1842 Johnson (D-37)

Requires Office of Counter Terrorism to train inspectors on identifying terrorist activity; creates grant program for inspectors to obtain radiation detection devices; appropriates \$300,000. (2006:A-1279; 2004:A-3808)

A-1843 Johnson (D-37)

Criminalizes purchase or possession of firearms ammunition by persons convicted of certain crimes. (2006:A-2601; 2004:A-4209)

A-1844 Johnson (D-37)

Requires members of State Police to undergo annual performance evaluations. (2006:S-1539; 2004:S-1266)

A-1845 Johnson (D-37)

Eliminates certain authorized messengers of absentee ballots; provides for appointed, bipartisan, two-person teams to assist voters; makes appropriation. (2006:A-3244)

A-1846 Johnson (D-37)

Requires absentee ballot totals be reported as group to ensure voter confidentiality. (2006:A-366; 2004:A-998)

A-1847 Johnson (D-37)

Establishes Task Force on Hospital Technology to recommend incentives to encourage hospitals to integrate technology to improve patient care and safety. (2006:A-402; 2004:A-2787)

A-1848 Johnson (D-37)

Provides DYFS caseworkers with personnel and law enforcement assistance when conducting DYFS investigations. (2008:S-1013; 2006:A-551; 2004:A-1328)

A-1849 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits sale of asbestos or asbestos-containing products.

A-1850 Johnson (D-37)

Requires DYFS to take certain actions to ensure caseworker safety. (2008:S-1012; 2006:A-540; 2004:A-694)

A-1851 Fisher (D-3)

Authorizes special Recreational Fishing Alliance license plate. (2006:S-2945)

A-1852 Conaway (D-7)

Requires insurers, Medicaid, and NJ FamilyCare to reimburse for childhood immunizations at levels specified by regulation. (2006:A-4182)

A-1853 Conaway (D-7)

"Long-Term Care Partnership Program Act"; establishes Long-Term Care Partnership Program in DHS. (2006:A-1640; 2004:S-2819)

A-1854 Conaway (D-7)

Directs DHS to declare surplus certain unused real property and provides for direct sale

thereof. (2006:A-1627; 2004:A-3923)

A-1855 Conaway (D-7)

Requires insurers and State health care coverage programs to cover cost of HPV vaccine. (2008:S-1016; 2006:A-4050)

A-1856 Conaway (D-7)

Excludes certain Medicare premiums in determining eligibility for PAAD and Senior Gold programs. (2006:A-1639; 2004:A-4575)

A-1857 Conaway (D-7)

Excludes certain premiums in determining PAAD eligibility. (2006:A-1620; 2004:A-2301)

A-1858 Conaway (D-7)

"State Medicare Part D Assistance and Information Act." (2006:A-2237)

A-1859 Conaway (D-7)

Requires health insurers to cover medically necessary expenses for preventing infertility in women undergoing chemotherapy or radiation therapy. (2006:A-1610; 2004:A-1498)

A-1860 Conaway (D-7)

Requires certain health care facilities to adopt certain infection control strategies. (2006:A-4045)

A-1861 Connors (D-7)

Establishes a financial or personal information "do not sell" list for residents of this State.

A-1862 Conaway (D-7)

Increases membership of Advisory Graduate Medical Education Council of NJ from 14 to 15 members.

A-1863 Conaway (D-7)

"Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act." (2006:A-3909)

A-1864 Conaway (D-7)

Prohibits municipalities from requiring permits for certain voter registration drives. (2006:A-2576; 2004:A-3585)

A-1865 Conaway (D-7)

Requires transportation services under Work First New Jersey program be provided for 24 months to recipients earning less than \$12 an hour. (2006:A-1605; 2004:A-1490)

A-1866 Conaway (D-7)

Enters New Jersey in Nurse Multistate Licensure Compact. (2006:A-4042)

A-1867 Conaway (D-7)

Requires Division of Taxation to provide certain information to applicants deemed ineligible. (2006:A-1630; 2004:A-4113)

A-1868 Conaway (D-7)

Permits municipalities to defer 100% of payment of property taxes owed by senior citizen homeowners enrolled in PAAD. (2006:A-1625; 2004:A-3296)

A-1869 Conaway (D-7)

Creates 14 additional judgeships; raises court fees. (2006:A-1633; 2004:A-4293)

A-1870 Conaway (D-7)

Prohibits persons under 19 from smoking in public and purchasing tobacco products. (2006:A-4181; 2004:S-755)

A-1871 Connors (D-7)

Requires certain physicians to complete course in recognizing and reporting child abuse and neglect. (2006:A-2609; 2004:A-3679)

A-1872 Connors (D-7)

Clarifies financial liability of certain cellular telephone service users upon notification of unauthorized use of cellular telephone. (2006:A-1447; 2004:A-2383)

A-1873 Connors (D-7)

Requires examinations of joint insurance funds and certain reporting by those funds. (2006:A-1443; 2004:A-1394)

A-1874 Connors (D-7)

Prohibits hold or block on debit card accounts unless disclosed to and authorized by consumer. (2006:A-1449; 2004:A-2564)

A-1875 Connors (D-7)

Prohibits certain practices by automobile insurers. (2006:A-1444; 2004:A-1396)

A-1876 Connors (D-7)

Requires MVC to accept death certificate as proof of name change. (2006:A-1442; 2004:A-1393)

A-1877 Connors (D-7)

Provides that employees no longer must pay full cost of purchase of PERS, PFRS or TPAF credit for military service. (2006:A-2613; 2004:A-402)

A-1878 Connors (D-7)

Requires insurance producers to notify Commissioner of Banking and Insurance of any disciplinary action taken by non-governmental regulatory authority.

* A-1879 Diegnan (D-18)

Requires creditor to provide certain disclosures to borrower prior to residential mortgage loan closing.

* A-1880 Doherty (R-23); Chivukula (D-17)

Requires public referendum prior to issuance of general obligation bonds by local units.

* A-1881 Diegnan (D-18)

Provides gross income tax credit for payment of certain tolls to New Jersey Turnpike Authority, South Jersey Transportation Authority, and certain other toll roadways.

* A-1882 Cohen (D-20)

Permits three year payoff of accumulated deficits of municipal health insurance funds.

* A-1883 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits retail mercantile establishment from selling prepaid cellular telephones unless establishment first makes and retains photocopy of purchaser's driver's license or non-driver identification card. (2006:A-321; 2004:A-4586)

* A-1884 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits cellular telephone service providers from disclosing individual proprietary information without customer written consent. (2006:A-308; 2004:A-3097)

* A-1885 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits electronic mail service providers from implementing an electronic mail postage system. (2006:A-3098)

* A-1886 Cohen (D-20)

Provides for an extended term of imprisonment, supervision for life and sex offender registration for the crime of human trafficking under certain circumstances. (2006:A-2868)

* A-1887 Cohen (D-20)

"Judy and Nikki's Law"; provides for life imprisonment without parole for persons convicted of murder of a child 16 years of age or younger. (2006:A-2673)

* A-1888 Cohen (D-20)

Provides for certain ex-spouses to receive a widows' pension. (2006:A-3042)

* A-1889 Cohen (D-20)

Requires verification of presence of carbon monoxide detectors whenever code inspection occurs upon installation of fossil fuel-fired furnaces or water heaters in one or two-unit dwellings. (2006:A-3442)

* A-1890 Cohen (D-20)

Provides for civil action and treble damages for a violation of the "New Jersey

Trademark Counterfeit Act." (2006:A-2906; 2004:A-1858)

* A-1891 Cohen (D-20)

Allows application for PERS accidental disability benefit for injury sustained while employed at State psychiatric institution or correctional facility immediately prior to PERS membership. (2008:S-222; 2006:S-2192)

* A-1892 Cohen (D-20)

Establishes the crime of negligent homicide. (2006:A-3055)

* A-1893 Cohen (D-20)

Designated Kevin Apuzzio's Law; allows municipalities to provide increased survivor pensions for certain volunteer emergency workers and requires municipalities to provide health and life insurance coverage to volunteer firefighters. (2006:A-3610)

* A-1894 Cohen (D-20)

Requires genetic testing to determine paternity in non-dissolution cases. (2006:A-2467; 2004:A-1850)

* A-1895 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits charging of unauthorized fees by bail agents or agencies. (2006:A-304; 2004:A-2824)

* A-1896 Cohen (D-20)

Provides for identity theft verification passports under certain circumstances. (2006:A-3607)

* A-1897 Cohen (D-20)

Expands list of Safe Haven sites, provides drop-off location information be made available by 2-1-1 call centers; appropriates \$95,000. (2008:S-184; 2006:S-2843)

* A-1898 Cohen (D-20)

Makes it an unlawful employment practice to subject an employee to a hostile work environment. (2006:A-4209)

* A-1899 Cohen (D-20)

Requires health care providers to obtain informed consent from patients for use of certain reprocessed medical devices. (2006:A-3878)

* A-1900 Cohen (D-20)

Revises and expands New Jersey Trademark Anti-Counterfeiting Act. (2006:A-4136)

* A-1901 Cohen (D-20)

Provides that the State pay health care coverage for certain survivors of members of PFRS and SPRS. (2006:A-4414)

* A-1902 Cohen (D-20)

Prohibits organized delivery systems from denying participation in network to imaging centers willing to meet terms of contract. (2006:A-4186)

* A-1903 Cohen (D-20)

Requires certain persons seeking license to operate facility to provide magnetic resonance imaging services to undergo criminal history record background checks. (2006:A-305; 2004:S-950)

* A-1904 Greenstein (D-14); Handlin (R-13); Vainieri Huttle (D-37)

Requires adoption and distribution of constitutions and bylaws by county political party committees; requires certified list of committee members to be filed with county clerk. (2008:S-930)

* A-1905 Gusciora (D-15)

Allows corporation business tax and gross income tax credits for 50% of purchase cost of diesel engine conversion devices. (2006:A-2597; 2004:A-4295)

A-1906 Chivukula (D-17); DeAngelo (D-14); Rooney (R-39)

Requires interactive computer service to remove images, information, or data which depicts child engaged in prohibited sexual act from computer server or other storage device controlled or owned by the interactive computer service. (2006:A-2099; 2004:A-3390)

A-1907 Conaway (D-7); Chiappone (D-31)

Provides additional enforcement provisions under "Health Care Quality Act"; allows certain private causes of action for violations; expands administrative remedies; establishes enforcement fund. (2006:A-4149)

A-1908 Scalera (D-36); Roberts (D-5)

Requires DHSS and DHS to establish autism awareness program for emergency medical technicians, police officers, and firefighters. (2006:A-4058)

A-1909 Albano (D-1); Greenwald (D-6); Burzichelli (D-3)

Permits in-person wagering at casinos on results of professional sports events, subject to voter approval. (2006:A-1046; 2004:A-3493)

A-1910 McKeon (D-27)

Delays effective date of recycling tax. (2008:S-796)

A-1911 Scalera (D-36); Quigley (D-32); Prieto (D-32)

Establishes "New Jersey Partnership for Secure Schools Pilot Program" in Department of Education; appropriates \$3 million. (2006:A-2801)

A-1912 Fisher (D-3); Conaway (D-7); Albano (D-1)

Appropriates \$33 million from "Garden State Green Acres Preservation Trust Fund" for

State acquisition of lands for recreation and conservation purposes. (2006:A-4584)

A-1913 Fisher (D-3)

Removes appropriations for gypsy moth suppression from the municipal expenditure cap and county and municipal tax levy cap. (2008:S-306; 2006:A-4491)

* A-1914 Conaway (D-7); Conners (D-7)

Allows exclusion for calculation of adjusted tax levy for expenditures made by municipalities for "Main Street New Jersey" program.

* A-1915 Gusciora (D-15)

The "Pet Food Safety Act." (2006:A-4171)

* A-1916 Conaway (D-7); Conners (D-7)

Relieves municipalities along certain light rail lines of civil liability in Quiet Zones under certain circumstances.

* A-1917 Gusciora (D-15)

Establishes additional bases for disqualification of bidder under "Local Public Contracts Law" and clarifies existing law. (2006:A-913; 2004:A-2129)

* A-1918 Gusciora (D-15)

Increases the term of a municipal prosecutor from one year to three years. (2006:A-3079)

* A-1919 Conners (D-7)

Authorizes municipality to require enhanced notice of applications for development under MLUL by posting signs and expanding scope of individual notice to property owners within 400 feet of subject property.

* A-1920 Gusciora (D-15)

Directs the Office of the Attorney General to develop fee schedule for discovery in municipal court; imposes limit on fees charged for discovery in certain cases. (2006:A-3249)

* A-1921 Conners (D-7); Cruz-Perez (D-5)

Provides that certain disabled veterans may purchase special automobile insurance policies. (2006:A-1454; 2004:A-3163)

* A-1922 Gusciora (D-15)

Authorizes municipalities to require conformity with traffic performance objectives as condition of subdivision or site plan approval. (2006:A-2060; 2004:S-729)

* A-1923 Conners (D-7); Cruz-Perez (D-5)

Changes membership requirements of the Veterans' Services Council.

* A-1924 Gusciora (D-15)

Requires sharing of revenues derived from major developments situated near municipal borders under certain circumstances. (2006:A-927; 2004:A-3564)

* A-1925 Conners (D-7)

Requires public bodies under Open Public Meetings Act to display U.S. flag and recite Pledge of Allegiance at beginning of meeting.

* A-1926 Gusciora (D-15)

Requires the State to reimburse counties for costs incurred in connection with the operation of county prosecutors' offices. (2006:A-926; 2004:A-3489)

* A-1927 Conaway (D-7)

Revises requirement for school district participation in Alliance for Competitive Telecommunications program and requires consultation with New Jersey Association of School Business Officials on certain training. (2006:A-4361)

Upgrades assault on victims who are disabled. (2006:A-3070)

* A-1929 Conaway (D-7)

Increases TPAF cost of living adjustment from 60% to 100% of Consumer Price Index. (2006:A-1606; 2004:A-1494)

* A-1930 Gusciora (D-15)

Requires poll workers to have certain training in the federal "Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990". (2006:A-2174; 2004:A-2699)

* A-1931 Conaway (D-7)

Requires managed care plans to cover treatment of overweight and obesity in adults on fee-for-service basis. (2006:A-1613; 2004:A-1515)

* A-1932 Gusciora (D-15)

Creates nine-member New Jersey Legislative Elections Public Financing Study Commission. (2006:A-4274)

* A-1933 Conaway (D-7)

Permits physicians to refer patients to certain ambulatory care facilities in which they have financial interest. (2008:S-787)

* A-1934 Gusciora (D-15)

Requires electronic recording of purchases of over-the-counter drugs used to manufacture methamphetamine.

* A-1935 Conaway (D-7)

Requires anatomical research recovery organizations to register with DHSS. (2008:S-753; 2006:S-3046)

* A-1936 Conaway (D-7)

Immunizes policyholders from liability within policy limits when coverage exceeds New Jersey Property-Liability Insurance Guaranty Association statutory limit of \$300,000. (2006:A-1632; 2004:A-4180)

* A-1937 Chivukula (D-17)

Establishes NJ Commission on Global Climate Change. (2008:S-697; 2006:S-559)

* A-1938 Conaway (D-7)

Permits "opt out" of compulsory automobile insurance; reinstates financial responsibility laws; eliminates territorial rate caps. (2006:A-1618; 2004:A-1846)

* A-1939 Conaway (D-7)

The "New Jersey Health Insurance Connector Act."

* A-1940 Chivukula (D-17)

Requires development and implementation of mitigation plans for radon contamination in certain child care centers; requires DOE to develop such plans for child care centers operating in public schools, request funding, and implement plans when funded. (2008:S-694; 2006:S-551)

* A-1941 Oliver (D-34); Giblin (D-34)

Appropriates \$7 million in 1992 bond act monies for loans to fund dam restoration projects.

* A-1942 Chivukula (D-17)

Requires owners and employees of international labor matching or matchmaking organizations to undergo background check and these organizations' recruits be given domestic violence information. (2006:A-807; 2004:A-3699)
