S-1037 Buono (D-18)

Removes licensing requirement for recreational senior citizen bingo games. (2006:S-2761)

S-1038 Buono (D-18)

Permits new residential owner or occupant to pay average municipal authority residential sewerage service charge in first year when billing based on previous year's water usage by former owner or occupant. (2006:S-2827)

S-1039 Buono (D-18)

Requires carbon monoxide detectors in all school buildings. (2006:S-541; 2004:S-2842)

S-1040 Buono (D-18)

Authorizes two-year property tax exemptions for facade and frontage improvements in certain older municipalities. (2006:S-530; 2004:S-1339)

S-1041 Buono (D-18)

Authorizes municipality to require enhanced notice of applications for development under MLUL by posting signs and expanding scope of individual notice to property owners within 300 feet of subject property. (2006:S-1428)

S-1042 Buono (D-18)

Repeals law establishing Mandated Health Benefits Advisory Commission. (2006:S-1622)

S-1043 Buono (D-18)

Increases annual funding of Alcohol Education, Rehabilitation and Enforcement Fund. (2006:S-968; 2004:S-485)

S-1044 Buono (D-18)

Establishes defibrillator grant program in DHSS for placement of defibrillators in senior citizen centers. (2008:A-543; 2006:S-966; 2004:S-1565)

S-1045 Lance (R-23)

Requires court to issue animal protective orders against persons found guilty of abusing animals. (2008:A-820; 2006:S-2246)

S-1046 Lance (R-23)

Extends limit for nonpublic school busing to 30 miles for pupils residing in Cumberland, Sussex, Hunterdon, Warren, Salem and Gloucester Counties who attend schools both within and outside the State. (2006:S-2395)

S-1047 Lance (R-23)

Prohibits contributions by administrator of Type II school district to candidates for member of district's school board; restricts employment by Type II school district of contributors to election campaign of member of district's school board. (2006:S-1493; 2004:S-629)

S-1048 Lance (R-23)

Designates State Highway Route 31 as the "Route 31 Purple Heart Memorial Highway"; appropriates \$2,500. (2006:S-982; 2004:S-2699)

S-1049 Lance (R-23)

Authorizes reimbursement for EMT training from EMT Training Fund for certain volunteer firefighters. (2006:S-2726)

S-1050 Lance (R-23)

Exempts volunteer fire companies from charitable registration fees. (2008:A-660; 2006:S-1045; 2004:S-1473)

S-1051 Lance (R-23)

Authorizes temporary handicapped parking permits for certain relatives of nursing home residents. (2008:A-662; 2006:S-1043; 2004:S-1356)

S-1052 Lance (R-23)

Prohibits political contributions by out-of-State casinos and certain individuals and business entities associated therewith. (2006:S-1494; 2004:S-1441)

S-1053 Singer (R-30)

Includes hedge fund fraud as consumer fraud act violation. (2008:A-1971; 2006:A-4216)

S-1054 Turner (D-15)

Establishes the "Mental Health Court Pilot Program." (2008:A-1166; 2006:S-2924; 2004:A-1279)

S-1055 Turner (D-15)

Imposes mandatory interest payment on delinquent child support judgments. (2008:A-117; 2006:S-1954)

S-1056 Turner (D-15)

Establishes the "Mental Health Court Pilot Program," in Mercer and Essex Counties. (2006:S-2578)

S-1057 Turner (D-15)

Authorizes injunctions against gangs.

S-1058 Turner (D-15)

Clarifies that school bus for purpose of upgraded penalties in "school zone" criminal drug laws includes any bus owned and operated by board of education or by private contractor. (2006:S-1437; 2004:S-730)

S-1059 Turner (D-15)

Requires DEP to designate one site in State park or forest where all-terrain vehicles may be used. (2006:S-2015)

S-1060 Turner (D-15)

Requires conditionally discharged drug dependent persons to undergo assessment and drug treatment. (2006:S-1631; 2004:S-2321)

S-1061 Turner (D-15)

Authorizes municipal court judges to hold hearings on complaints involving unsafe buildings and authorizes housing inspectors to issue summonses. (2006:S-1209; 2004:S-2256)

S-1062 Turner (D-15)

Prohibits retail mercantile establishment from selling prepaid cellular telephones unless establishment first makes and retains photocopy of purchaser's driver's license or non-driver identification card. (2006:A-321; 2004:A-4586)

S-1063 Smith, B. (D-17); Kyrillos (R-13)

Requires DOLWD to adopt air quality standards for public school buildings and appropriates \$250,000 to DOLWD to enforce those standards. (2006:S-550; 2004:S-1130)

S-1064 Smith, B. (D-17)

Allows for 75% of costs of energy audits undertaken for commercial buildings be paid for by societal benefits charge. (2006:S-2921)

S-1065 Smith, B. (D-17); Baroni (R-14)

Permits electric public utilities, electric power suppliers and basic generation service providers to enter into certain agreements with building owners for use of solar energy systems for such buildings. (2006:S-2917)

S-1066 Smith, B. (D-17); Sarlo (D-36)

Permits developer to qualify for low-interest loan from NJEDA when building a high performance green building. (2008:A-2065; 2006:S-2918)

S-1067 Bucco (R-25)

Requires the reporting of criminal offenses occurring on school property to law enforcement authorities. (2006:S-235; 2004:S-1075)

S-1068 Bucco (R-25)

Individual's status as minor shall not disqualify him from bone marrow donation. (2006:S-925; 2004:S-1201)

S-1069 Bucco (R-25)

Requires health insurers to provide coverage for positron emission tomography to diagnose Alzheimer's disease. (2006:S-228; 2004:S-404)

S-1070 Bucco (R-25)

Allows taxpayers to deduct adoption expenses from gross income. (2006:S-895; 2004:S-1082)

S-1071 Bucco (R-25)

Provides for conscientious exemption to mandatory immunizations. (2008:A-260; 2006:S-2684; 2004:A-2616)

S-1072 Bucco (R-25)

Permits Legislature to void closing of State psychiatric hospital or developmental center. (2006:S-924; 2004:S-413)

S-1073 Bucco (R-25)

Adds members representing fire fighting and fire safety interests to the Domestic Security Preparedness Planning Group. (2006:S-908; 2004:S-1251)

S-1074 Bucco (R-25)

Clarifies that crime victims' rights must be recognized by all courts in the State. (2006:S-909; 2004:S-1077)

S-1075 Bucco (R-25)

Clarifies that using motor vehicle to publicly display obscene material is fourth degree crime. (2006:S-1039; 2004:S-2271)

S-1076 Bucco (R-25)

Increases certain arson offenses to a crime of the third degree. (2006:S-907; 2004:S-1085)

S-1077 Smith, B. (D-17)

The "Green Building Tax Credit Act." (2008:A-2070)

S-1078 Lance (R-23)

Permits tax credit against gross income tax for certain adoption expenses. (2006:S-977; 2004:S-1440)

S-1079 Bateman (R-16)

"Plastic Carryout Bag and Film Plastic Recycling Act."

S-1080 Ciesla (R-10)

Authorizes court to require persons convicted of refusing breathalyzer for second or subsequent time to install ignition interlock. (2006:S-2992)

S-1081 Ciesla (R-10)

Omits State Police detectives from Open Public Records Act. (2006:S-2730)

S-1082 Ciesla (R-10)

Permits municipality to determine permissible parking distance from intersection, crosswalk or "stop" sign. (2008:A-1775; 2006:S-2990)

S-1083 Ciesla (R-10)

Reduces certain stop sign no parking zones from 50 feet to 30 feet. (2006:S-2993)

S-1084 Ciesla (R-10)

Authorizes MVC to give refunds for unexpired portions of motor vehicle registration periods in certain cases. (2006:S-2991; 2004:A-423)

S-1085 Madden (D-4)

Concerns access to wage records in connection with projects subject to prevailing wage requirements. (2008:A-2074; 2006:S-2839)

S-1086 Madden (D-4); Van Drew (D-1)

Repeals provision allowing vehicles, under certain conditions, to enter and proceed through stop intersection without stopping twice. (2008:A-1291; 2006:A-965; 2004:A-626)

S-1087 Sarlo (D-36)

Makes it unlawful practice to sell certain products via Internet auction. (2006:A-3866)

S-1088 Kean, S. (R-11)

Prohibits requiring school and county college employees to search for or handle explosive devices. (2006:A-3876; 2004:A-2955)

S-1089 Bucco (R-25)

Establishes "William's Law," pertaining to pool safety. (2008:A-1213; 2006:S-1042; 2004:A-4221)

S-1090 Bucco (R-25)

Provides that English shall be the official language of the State. (2008:A-468; 2006:A-1099)

S-1091 Bucco (R-25)

Requires firefighters to obtain "firefighter 1" certification. (2008:A-1016; 2006:S-1038; 2004:S-2668)

S-1092 Bucco (R-25)

Abolishes Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission, transfers bridges to NJ DOT and Penn DOT, removes tolls. (2006:S-243; 2004:S-2792)

S-1093 Bucco (R-25)

Requires ATM facilities to be equipped with access to emergency telephone service. (2006:S-1072; 2004:S-1335)

S-1094 Bucco (R-25)

Provides for attachment of real property relating to terrorism. (2008:A-1569; 2006:S-1182; 2004:S-412)

S-1095 Bucco (R-25)

Prohibits sale and distribution of certain tobacco related products to persons under 19 years of age. (2006:S-2527)

S-1096 Smith, B. (D-17); Bateman (R-16)

Creates Solar and Wind Energy Commission.

S-1097 Haines (R-8)

Prohibits release on bail of persons in the country illegally who are charged with crimes of the first or second degree or with two prior criminal convictions. (2008:A-1782)

S-1098 Haines (R-8)

Exempts renewable energy systems from real property taxation and from fees for municipal construction permits. (2008:A-1781)

S-1099 Buono (D-18)

Permits nonpartisan municipal elections to be held on same day as general election. (2008:A-351; 2006:S-2243; 2004:A-3364)

S-1100 Buono (D-18)

Authorizes actions for damages for computer impersonation and electronic forgery. (2006:S-1624; 2004:S-1051)

S-1101 Buono (D-18)

Authorizes actions for damages for computer embezzlement. (2008:A-745; 2006:S-1623; 2004:S-1054)

S-1102 Buono (D-18)

Requires health benefits coverage for bone mass measurement. (2006:S-1053; 2004:S-481)

S-1103 Buono (D-18)

Authorizes State and local governments to enter into group purchasing agreement for alternative fueled vehicles. (2006:S-960; 2004:S-2817)

S-1104 Buono (D-18)

Provides that public schools will not be in session on general election days when Office of President of the United States is on ballot. (2006:S-991; 2004:S-2204)

S-1105 Buono (D-18)

Requires State aid for operating expenses of higher education institutions as a percentage of the State budget to equal national average. (2008:A-721; 2006:S-988; 2004:S-1587)

S-1106 Buono (D-18); Beck (R-12) +2

Amends stalking law to broaden protections for victims. (2008:A-1563; 2006:S-3051)

S-1107 Buono (D-18)

Allows municipalities to double fines for moving motor vehicle violations in school zones. (2006:S-999; 2004:S-482)

S-1108 Buono (D-18)

Establishes "CARE Unit" in Division of Criminal Justice to fight crime against the elderly; makes an appropriation. (2006:S-533; 2004:S-1566)

S-1109 Buono (D-18)

Requires breath or blood sample to be obtained from driver involved in motor vehicle accident resulting in death. (2006:S-1000; 2004:S-2686)

S-1110 Buono (D-18); Madden (D-4)

Establishes "In Case of Emergency Contact Program." (2008:A-840; 2006:S-2420)

S-1111 Buono (D-18)

Increases drunk driving enforcement surcharge. (2008:A-860; 2006:S-523; 2004:S-475)

S-1112 Buono (D-18)

Imposes surcharge on drunk drivers to establish Drunk Driving Prevention and Education Grant Fund. (2008:A-859; 2006:S-526; 2004:S-483)

S-1113 Buono (D-18)

Provides credit against corporation business tax for taxpayers supporting child care facilities for employees. (2006:S-961; 2004:S-472)

S-1114 Buono (D-18)

Allows corporation business tax credit and gross income tax credit for certain costs of operating sick child care centers. (2006:S-525; 2004:S-480)

S-1115 Buono (D-18)

Allows corporation business tax credit and gross income tax credit for employer expenditures to provide certain physical fitness benefits to employees. (2008:A-1312; 2006:S-527; 2004:S-484)

S-1116 Buono (D-18)

Allows gross income tax credits for certain dependent and child care expenses. (2006:S-962; 2004:S-470)

S-1117 Smith, B. (D-17); Beck (R-12)

Establishes financial incentives for certain energy providers to conduct energy audits. (2006:S-2920)

S-1118 Beck (R-12)

Requires NJ Transit to provide on-time performance data for bus passenger service in its annual report.

S-1119 Kean, T. (R-21)

Permits parent of stillborn child to request certificate of birth resulting in stillbirth directly from State registrar. (2006:A-4565)

S-1120 Kean, T. (R-21)

Requires global warming index label on new motor vehicles beginning in model year 2010. (2006:S-2774)

S-1121 Kean, T. (R-21)

Provides credit under corporation business tax and gross income tax for construction of buildings in accordance with certain energy and environmental performance standards. (2006:S-1940)

S-1122 Sacco (D-32); Kean, S. (R-11) +1

Authorizes construction of curb extensions for pedestrian safety on local roadways without Commissioner of Transportation's approval. (2006:S-2511)

S-1123 Oroho (R-24)

Authorizes inclusion of compulsive gambling education in public school curriculum; requires higher education institutions to provide compulsive gambling education programs and services. (2006:S-1742)

S-1124 Oroho (R-24); Bucco (R-25)

Prohibits DOT from putting tolls on I-78 and I-80 and from transferring jurisdiction to independent authority or entity. (2008:A-1686; 2006:S-2461)

S-1125 Gill (D-34)

Requires installment payments for maternity services. (2008:A-1573; 2006:S-1445; 2004:A-2821)

S-1126 Gill (D-34)

Requires registration of qualified journeyman electricians and restricts exemption for certain electrical work by public electric utilities. (2006:S-951; 2004:S-1424)

S-1127 Gill (D-34)

Prohibits State agencies from including advertisements in mailings to public. (2006:S-2109)

S-1128 Gill (D-34)

Establishes a loan redemption program for teachers under which they are permitted to redeem loan amounts received under the New Jersey College Loans to Assist State Students Loan Program through employment in public schools in New Jersey. (2006:S-496; 2004:S-2131)

S-1129 Gill (D-34)

Allows a gross income tax deduction for certain higher education tuition and fee expenses. (2006:S-485; 2004:S-281)

S-1130 Gill (D-34)

Makes supplemental appropriation of \$100,000 for FY2008 to Kean University to fund the Wynona M. Lipman Ethnic Studies Center. (2006:S-489; 2004:S-639)

S-1131 Buono (D-18)

Restricts use of certain pesticides at certain schools, child care centers and family day care homes. (2006:S-545; 2004:S-2882)

S-1132 Buono (D-18)

"Adolescents' Online Privacy Protection Act." (2008:A-108; 2006:S-1625; 2004:S-473)

S-1133 Buono (D-18)

Requires 10 percent premium discount for good drivers who are with same insurer five or more years. (2008:A-1186; 2006:S-965; 2004:S-469)

S-1134 Buono (D-18)

Requires acquisition of defibrillators for use in public and nonpublic high schools and training of certain personnel in usage; appropriates \$900,000. (2006:S-524; 2004:S-478)

S-1135 Sweeney (D-3); Sarlo (D-36)

Prohibits boards of education from charging students a fee to participate in extracurricular activities. (2008:A-1489; 2006:S-2317)

S-1136 Sweeney (D-3)

Authorizes special license plates for former freeholders. (2006:S-2447)

S-1137 Van Drew (D-1)

Makes employment matters not exempted by statute mandatory subjects of public employment collective bargaining. (2008:A-1547; 2006:A-2752)

S-1138 Van Drew (D-1)

Prohibits financial institutions from charging any fee on sales and use tax portion of retail sales transaction.

S-1139 Van Drew (D-1)

Makes certain repeat offenders ineligible for parole. (2008:A-854; 2006:A-2193; 2004:A-413)

S-1140 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes procedures for selecting hearing officers in certain police disciplinary hearings. (2006:A-4448)

S-1141 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires Commissioner of Corrections to institute 15-minute shift overlap in State correctional facilities. (2008:A-1789; 2006:A-4202)

S-1142 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires criminal history background check for certain persons working at schools. (2008:A-176; 2006:A-1743; 2004:A-4454)

S-1143 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires corrections officers be notified when inmates test positive for certain communicable diseases. (2008:A-2223; 2006:A-4394)

S-1144 Van Drew (D-1)

Authorizes police officers to waive local disciplinary hearings and appeal to administrative law judge in civil service and Superior Court judge in non-civil service municipalities. (2006:A-4444)

S-1145 Van Drew (D-1)

Enhances penalties for driving when license revoked. (2008:A-862; 2006:A-2832)

S-1146 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires disciplinary actions against police officers be based exclusively on rules and regulations adopted by the appropriate authority. (2006:A-4445)

S-1147 Van Drew (D-1)

Clarifies chief of police is responsible for disciplining subordinates. (2006:A-4446)

S-1148 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires civilian employees of DOC to be trained in gang awareness. (2008:A-1790; 2006:A-4204)

S-1149 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes special license plates for World War II veterans. (2006:A-2091; 2004:A-2149)

S-1150 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires 40 hours annual in-service training for State corrections officers. (2008:A-1791; 2006:A-4201)

S-1151 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires home interview of corrections officer applicants. (2008:A-1798; 2006:A-4205)

S-1152 Van Drew (D-1)

Authorizes Boy Scouts license plate. (2006:A-2223; 2004:A-2329)

S-1153 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires internal affairs investigations to be conducted by unit separate from unit responsible for collecting gang intelligence information. (2008:A-1793; 2006:A-4206)

S-1154 Van Drew (D-1)

Provides that only certain DOC employees may recruit, interview, and hire corrections officers. (2008:A-1788; 2006:A-4203)

S-1155 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires State to offer surplus State police vehicles to certain volunteer fire and emergency service organizations. (2006:A-1035; 2004:A-2755)

S-1156 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires serological testing for hepatitis of certain defendants. (2008:A-867; 2006:A-3060)

S-1157 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires inmates with sufficient means to pay their incarceration costs. (2008:A-223; 2006:A-2334; 2004:A-2951)

S-1158 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires State Auditor review of certain Department of Corrections privatization contracts. (2008:A-1795; 2006:A-2168; 2004:A-3304)

S-1159 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires notification to corrections officers when disturbance occurs in correctional facility. (2008:A-2009; 2006:A-4199)

S-1160 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes aid program for certain municipalities with State correctional facilities. (2006:A-1043; 2004:A-3331)

S-1161 Van Drew (D-1)

Authorizes paid leaves of absence for certain delegates of employee organizations representing corrections officers when attending conventions. (2006:A-3665)

S-1162 Van Drew (D-1)

"New Jersey Fair Market Drug Pricing Act"; establishes New Jersey Rx Card Program to reduce prescription drug prices. (2008:A-1799; 2006:A-1032)

S-1163 Whelan (D-2)

Expands coverage under "New Jersey Horse Racing Injury Compensation Board Act" to thoroughbred hot walkers, grooms, and assistant trainers under certain circumstances.

S-1164 Whelan (D-2)

Appropriates \$1,068,921 from "Garden State Historic Preservation Trust Fund" to provide historic site management grants for certain historic preservation projects. (2008:A-2224)

S-1165 Adler (D-6); Singer (R-30)

Regulates certain credentialing and trade practices of insurance producers, and provides private cause of action for insurance producer violations.

S-1166 Smith, B. (D-17)

Authorizes creation and operation of stormwater utility systems.

S-1167 Bateman (R-16); Van Drew (D-1)

Appropriates \$8,430,250 from various Green Acres funds for grants to certain nonprofit entities to acquire or develop lands for recreation and conservation purposes. (2008:A-2226)

S-1168 Adler (D-6)

Appropriates \$54,917,725 from various Green Acres funds for local government open space acquisition and park development projects. (2008:A-2225)

* S-1169 Connors, C. (R-9)

Requires public hearings on proposed off-track wagering facilities to be held in municipalities contiguous to site where proposed facilities will be located. (2008:A-304; 2006:S-2279)

* S-1170 Connors, C. (R-9)

Requires State to reimburse counties and municipalities for salary and fringe benefit costs of employee on official leave of absence for military service in war on terror; makes an appropriation. (2008:A-2193; 2006:A-2584)

* S-1171 Connors, C. (R-9)

Revises laws restricting operation of personal watercraft and permits local police enforcement. (2006:S-139; 2004:S-654)

* S-1172 Sweeney (D-3); Weinberg (D-37)

Prohibits certain elected officials from receiving dual health benefit coverage. (2006:S-1125; 2004:S-593)

* S-1173 Rice (D-28)

Requires school districts to notify DOE of sicknesses resulting from confirmed or suspected air pollution or other contamination. (2006:S-2834)

* S-1174 Rice (D-28)

Makes supplemental appropriation of \$30,000,000 to UMDNJ for expansion and renovation of clinical facilities at New Jersey Dental School. (2006:S-1764)

Requires certain districts to develop a program of after school activities and provides for voter approval of additional local funding. (2006:S-1606; 2004:S-2950)
