S-764 Singer (R-30)

"Hybrid Swimming Pool Heating Act."

S-765 Singer (R-30)

Directs Secretary of Agriculture to determine annually areas for gypsy moth control measures and implement control measures; specifies State pay full implementation cost; appropriates \$5,500,000. (2006:S-2875)

S-766 Singer (R-30)

Designates Grove of Remembrance at Liberty State Park as official State memorial; appropriates \$90,000 for benches and maintenance. (2006:A-4636)

S-767 Singer (R-30)

Establishes pilot program to allow the installation of video cameras on school buses used to transport classified students in the Jackson Township School District. (2006:S-2385)

S-768 Singer (R-30)

Requires candidates for teaching certificates and current teachers to receive instruction in autism awareness and methods of teaching students with autism. (2006:S-2416)

S-769 Kean, T. (R-21)

Eliminates provision that permits current members of Legislature who hold more than one elective public office on February 1, 2008 to continue to do so if service is continuous.

S-770 Rice (D-28); Van Drew (D-1)

Redefines role and qualifications of purchasing agent in "Local Public Contracts Law." (2006:S-2829; 2004:A-4073)

S-771 Rice (D-28)

Revises eligibility for expungement of criminal and juvenile delinquency records. (2006:S-2935)

S-772 Rice (D-28)

Concerns certificates of occupancy for public housing projects.

S-773 Rice (D-28)

Establishes division of Department of Treasury to oversee and enforce equal employment opportunity requirements with regard to public works contracts.

S-774 Rice (D-28)

Requires mandatory audit of new voter registration records before an election and of

absentee and provisional ballots after an election in randomly selected districts.

S-775 Kyrillos (R-13)

Requires electronic bulletin board on DCA website for local units to advertise shared services opportunities; requires development of computerized survey to match local units together to implement shared services. (2006:S-2293)

S-776 Kyrillos (R-13)

Prohibits sale and possession of disguised knives. (2006:S-1118)

S-777 Kyrillos (R-13)

Authorizes debarment of bidders convicted of certain crimes and disqualification of certain public contract bidders for employees' crimes. (2006:S-596; 2004:S-2836)

S-778 Kyrillos (R-13)

Changes way electors for President and Vice President of the United States are selected in State. (2006:S-580; 2004:S-1855)

S-779 Kyrillos (R-13)

Upgrades crime of soliciting or recruiting for criminal street gang while on school property. (2006:S-731; 2004:S-2354)

S-780 Kyrillos (R-13)

Exempts from realty transfer fees, sales of homes of certain New Jersey members of the military. (2006:S-583; 2004:S-2079)

S-781 Kyrillos (R-13)

Concerns availability of basic and "Dollar-A-Day" automobile insurance policies. (2006:S-579; 2004:S-1703)

S-782 Kyrillos (R-13)

Prohibits issuance of DEP permits or approvals for activities associated with offshore drilling for oil or natural gas. (2006:S-592; 2004:S-2657)

S-783 Kyrillos (R-13)

Permits unused vacation and sick leave by public employee to be carried forward for one year only; requires unused administrative leave to be cancelled. (2006:S-2172)

S-784 Sweeney (D-3)

Raises minimum wage to \$8.50, then makes annual adjustments based on increases in the Statewide average weekly wage.

S-785 Sweeney (D-3)

Concerns certain workers' compensation supplemental benefits.

S-786 Sweeney (D-3); Buono (D-18)

Extends TDI to provide family leave benefits for workers caring for sick family members, newborn and newly adopted children.

S-787 Codey (D-27); Adler (D-6)

Permits physicians to refer patients to certain ambulatory care facilities in which they have financial interest. (2008:A-1933)

S-788 Lance (R-23)

Provides for State constitutional convention to reduce government spending and to reform system of property taxation; makes appropriation. (2006:S-709; 2004:S-1392)

S-789 Lance (R-23)

Eliminates awards of punitive damages against public entities, and against public officers, employees and servants acting within the scope or under color of their office, employment or agency. (2006:S-704; 2004:S-635)

S-790 Lance (R-23)

Repeals gross receipts and use taxes on retail sales of fur clothing. (2006:S-2411)

S-791 Lance (R-23)

Changes date for election of fire district commissioners from third Saturday in February to day of general election. (2006:S-1187; 2004:S-1355)

S-792 Lance (R-23)

Phases out the transfer inheritance tax over two years. (2006:S-978; 2004:S-1875)

S-793 Lance (R-23)

Appropriates \$400,000 to the Department of Agriculture for honeybee resources support. (2006:S-2765)

S-794 Lance (R-23)

Provides for the election of school board members at November general election. (2006:S-708; 2004:S-1360)

S-795 Sarlo (D-36)

Appropriates \$33 million from "Garden State Green Acres Preservation Trust Fund" for State acquisition of lands for recreation and conservation purposes. (2006:S-2966)

S-796 Smith, B. (D-17)

Delays effective date of recycling tax. (2008:A-1910)

S-797 Ciesla (R-10); Sacco (D-32)

Upgrades penalties for drag racing. (2006:S-2842)

\* S-798 Ciesla (R-10)

Extends certain benefits to members of U.S. Reserves and State organized militia who

serve at least 180 continuous days. (2006:S-1309; 2004:S-1380)

\* S-799 Sarlo (D-36)

Increases penalties for counterfeiting if public health is threatened; creates new offense within Criminal Code of counterfeiting products related to health.

\* S-800 Cunningham (D-31)

Exempts veterans from \$15 fee for open and competitive civil service examinations and from local residency requirements.

\* S-801 Sweeney (D-3)

Permits municipalities to agree to share municipal court services while each appointing their own municipal court judge. (2006:S-2850)

\* S-802 Sweeney (D-3); O'Toole (R-40)

Authorizes deer hunting with bow and arrow on Sundays. (2008:A-1669; 2006:A-2472)

\* S-803 Sweeney (D-3)

The "Restoring the Ranks of Full-Time Faculty Act"; requires public institutions of higher education to ensure minimum level of full-time teaching faculty. (2006:A-4364)

\* S-804 Sweeney (D-3)

Requires candidates nominated by direct petition for general election to file petitions on same day as candidates seeking nomination in primary must file petitions of nomination.

\* S-805 Sweeney (D-3)

Adds supplementary budget language authorizing deposit and utilization of monies recovered from MTBE contamination. (2006:S-2944)

\* S-806 Sweeney (D-3)

Establishes registry of community agency employees providing services to persons with developmental disabilities. (2006:S-224; 2004:S-2740)

\* S-807 Sweeney (D-3)

Requires DHSS to make reported information about certain adverse events publicly available. (2008:A-1264; 2006:A-4327)

\* S-808 Sweeney (D-3)

Requires municipal prosecutors to review and transmit driver abstract to judge prior to recommending plea agreements for unsafe driving.

\* S-809 Sweeney (D-3)

Clarifies that licensed dealers may provide firearms for display at fund raising events sponsored by certain tax exempt organizations.

\* S-810 Sweeney (D-3)

Waives commercial driver's license fees for certain volunteer firefighters.

\* S-811 Sweeney (D-3)

Confers civil service status on police officers employed by UMDNJ and Rutgers University. (2008:A-377; 2006:A-4190)

\* S-812 Sweeney (D-3)

Increases county portion of payment in lieu of tax; requires portion of payment to be paid to school district and notice of public hearing on financial agreement to board of freeholders and school board. (2006:S-2731)

\* S-813 Sweeney (D-3)

Creates 14 additional judgeships; raises court fees. (2006:S-478; 2004:S-2551)

\* S-814 Sweeney (D-3)

Concerns rights of DRPA employees. (2006:S-1798)

\* S-815 Sweeney (D-3)

Authorizes civil action for certain economic damages against owner or keeper of pet animal that injures or kills another person's pet animal. (2006:S-2453)

\* S-816 Sweeney (D-3)

Provides exclusive jurisdiction for PERC certain unfair labor practice claims. (2006:S-2637)

\* S-817 Sweeney (D-3)

Permits labor peace agreements in projects in which public entities have proprietary interests. (2006:S-2974)

\* S-818 Sweeney (D-3)

Makes solid waste collection and transportation contracts subject to prevailing wage requirements.

\* S-819 Sweeney (D-3)

Extends unemployment benefits to certain college and university adjunct faculty members.

\* S-820 Sweeney (D-3)

Allows certain chiropractors licensed in other states to be licensed in New Jersey. (2006:S-1066; 2004:S-2778)

\* S-821 Sweeney (D-3)

Prohibits display of political campaign signs on any public property.

\* S-822 Bucco (R-25)

Allows for certain variances, exemptions, and waivers under "Highlands Water

Protection and Planning Act." (2006:S-242; 2004:S-2750)

\* S-823 Ciesla (R-10)

Requires retail establishments to allow individuals with certain medical conditions access to employee restrooms.

\* S-824 Ciesla (R-10)

Permits use of overseas absentee ballots for all elections.

\* S-825 Ciesla (R-10)

Concerns eligibility for unemployment compensation for data collectors.

\* S-826 Ciesla (R-10)

Provides grants and tax credits for school districts and private contractors for installing cameras on school buses. (2006:S-2128)

\* S-827 Ciesla (R-10)

Increases penalties for violations committed by provisional driver's license holder. (2006:S-2533)

\* S-828 Ciesla (R-10)

Authorizes special parking insignias for passenger automobiles used to transport the developmentally disabled. (2006:S-1323)

\* S-829 Ciesla (R-10)

Authorizes special "Brain Tumor Awareness" license plates with proceeds to support certain New Jersey brain tumor support groups. (2006:S-2880)

\* S-830 Ciesla (R-10)

Allows TPAF retiree to be employed as certificated superintendent or administrator for limited time frame due to critical need without TPAF reenrollment. (2006:S-2994)

\* S-831 Ciesla (R-10)

Provides credit under corporation business tax and gross income tax for marinas and boatyards that follow certain environmentally sound management practices. (2006:S-2881)

\* S-832 Ciesla (R-10)

Prohibits Pinelands Commission from requiring pinelands development credits for the construction of development project that includes affordable housing. (2006:S-2277)

\* S-833 Ciesla (R-10)

Exempts senior citizens and blind or disabled persons from certain realty transfer fees. (2006:S-1442; 2004:S-1960)

\* S-834 Ciesla (R-10)

Eliminates supplemental realty transfer fee. (2006:S-874; 2004:S-1327)

\* S-835 Ciesla (R-10)

Establishes animal cruelty offenses pertaining to chaining or other restraint of animals. (2006:S-1705)

\* S-836 Ciesla (R-10)

"Homestead School Property Tax Reimbursement Act"; provides State reimbursement for 50% of school property taxes paid by seniors, 65 years and older. (2006:S-939; 2004:S-293)

\* S-837 Ciesla (R-10)

Authorizes leave for parents and guardians of children with special needs. (2006:S-1443; 2004:S-440)

\* S-838 Ciesla (R-10)

Supplemental appropriation of \$5 million to DHS to develop community residences for Division of Developmental Disabilities clients on the waiting list. (2006:S-1839)

\* S-839 Ciesla (R-10)

Removes certain employed family members from unemployment insurance exemption. (2006:S-2722)

\* S-840 Ciesla (R-10)

Provides for annual adjustment in allowance paid to veterans with certain wartime service-connected disabilities. (2006:S-1308; 2004:S-290)

\* S-841 Ciesla (R-10)

Revises criteria for eligibility to receive senior and disabled homestead property tax reimbursement. (2006:S-2500; 2004:A-733)

\* S-842 O'Toole (R-40)

Prohibits candidates and elected public officials charged with crimes from using campaign contributions for their legal defense. (2008:A-965; 2006:A-4246)

\* S-843 Weinberg (D-37)

Increases railroad franchise and property taxes to support improvements to railroad capital facilities. (2006:S-1795)

\* S-844 Weinberg (D-37)

Requires NJ Sports and Exposition Authority to notify and receive input from Hackensack Meadowlands Development Commission and Hackensack Meadowlands District municipalities concerning certain Meadowlands complex projects. (2006:S-676; 2004:A-343)

\* S-845 Weinberg (D-37)

Prohibits display of political campaign signs on any public property or highway.

\* S-846 Cardinale (R-39); Sarlo (D-36)

Requires consumer complaints to licensing boards of regulated professions to be resolved within 100 days.

\* S-847 Kyrillos (R-13)

Changes criminal penalties for theft of fuel. (2006:S-595; 2004:S-2808)

\* S-848 Kyrillos (R-13)

Provides that trespassing in nuclear power plant is third degree crime. (2006:S-2546)

\* S-849 Kyrillos (R-13)

Requires DEP to post waterfront public access points on Internet. (2006:S-591; 2004:S-2656)

\* S-850 Kyrillos (R-13)

Permits county recording officer to record electronic image documents at time of receipt. (2006:S-599; 2004:S-2920)

\* S-851 Kyrillos (R-13)

Requires ambulances to be equipped with global positioning system technology. (2006:S-582; 2004:S-2022)

\* S-852 Kyrillos (R-13)

Establishes New Jersey Commission on State Advertisements and Promotions; prohibits appearance of Governor in State advertisements or promotions unless appearance is essential to achieve public purpose. (2006:S-584; 2004:S-2120)

\* S-853 Kyrillos (R-13)

Creates an Official Corruption Unit in the Division of State Police. (2006:S-589; 2004:S-2478)

\* S-854 Kyrillos (R-13)

Requires retail gasoline stations to maintain alternative power generation devices and allows credit against corporation business tax and New Jersey income tax for purchase of generation devices. (2006:S-2547)

\* S-855 Kyrillos (R-13)

Establishes a "State Authorities Review Commission." (2006:S-2097)

\* S-856 Kyrillos (R-13)

Provides that person who impersonates law enforcement officer and commits crime is guilty of third degree crime. (2006:S-2548)

\* S-857 Lance (R-23)

Moves school, fire district and certain municipal elections to date of nonpartisan municipal elections. (2006:S-1188; 2004:S-1468)

\* S-858 Lance (R-23)

Prohibits use of equipment and facilities to produce obscene materials in public school districts and public institutions of higher education. (2006:S-980; 2004:S-1243)

\* S-859 Lance (R-23)

Provides procedure for approving airport expansion; provides assistance to affected property owners. (2006:S-973; 2004:S-1358)

\* S-860 Lance (R-23)

Regulates involvement of candidates and officeholders with issue advocacy organizations. (2006:S-1256; 2004:S-627)

\* S-861 Lance (R-23)

Requires DOT to provide for removal of deer carcasses from county and municipal roads; appropriates \$730,000. (2006:S-2271)

\* S-862 Lance (R-23)

Prohibits filling of vacancy among candidates nominated at primaries after 48th and before 14th day before general election, except due to death; prohibits filling subsequent vacancies before elections. (2006:S-1186; 2004:S-1548)

\* S-863 Lance (R-23)

Authorizes assessment of development impact fees by municipalities. (2006:S-972; 2004:S-623)

\* S-864 Connors, C. (R-9)

Concerns awarding of professional services contracts by public agencies and requires certain disclosures by State and local government officials and candidates for elective public office.

\* S-865 Connors, C. (R-9)

Authorizes free hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses and free admission State parks and forests for individuals with certain types of military service. (2006:S-1133; 2004:A-952)

\* S-866 Connors, C. (R-9)

Regulates power vessels in certain environmentally sensitive areas. (2006:S-1384; 2004:A-932)

\* S-867 Connors, C. (R-9)

Allows municipalities to provide free or reduced fee beach badges to active military and NJ National Guard personnel. (2006:S-140; 2004:S-669)

\* S-868 Connors, C. (R-9)

Requires court to consider results of domestic violence assessment before dissolving certain domestic violence restraining orders. (2008:A-301; 2006:A-3276)

\* S-869 Turner (D-15)

Permits municipalities to adopt ordinances requiring bond from landlords in certain circumstances. (2006:S-1214; 2004:S-728)

\* S-870 Connors, C. (R-9)

Broadens eligibility for certain veterans' benefits by eliminating requirement of service during specified dates or in specified locations. (2006:S-1500; 2004:S-971)

\* S-871 Turner (D-15)

Requires DEP to designate smoke-free sections of State beaches, parks, and forests. (2006:S-2984)

\* S-872 Turner (D-15)

Sets States mileage reimbursement rate at IRS rate for business use of automobile. (2006:S-748; 2004:S-1595)

\* S-873 Turner (D-15)

Requires cost analysis in certain cases when State department contracts out work. (2006:S-1345; 2004:S-767)

\* S-874 Turner (D-15)

Enhances penalties upon certain violators of housing codes. (2006:S-1212; 2004:S-2182)

\* S-875 Turner (D-15)

Establishes pilot program in Department of Law and Public Safety using infrared sensors to facilitate roadside truck safety inspections. (2006:S-1629; 2004:S-739)

\* S-876 Turner (D-15)

Provides for sales tax exemption for advanced technology partial zero emission vehicles, imposes surcharge on certain automobiles. (2008:A-822; 2006:A-4113)

\* S-877 Turner (D-15)

Establishes the New Jersey Task Force on Child Support Reform. (2006:S-751; 2004:S-2459)

\* S-878 Turner (D-15)

Restricts large trucks to certain highway networks. (2006:S-1515; 2004:S-2458)

\* S-879 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes the Travel and Tourism Supplemental Revenue Fund. (2006:A-1031; 2004:A-1934)

\* S-880 Gill (D-34)

Appropriates \$200,000 from "Garden State Green Acres Preservation Trust Fund" for grant to Save Ellis Island, Inc. to develop lands for recreation and conservation purposes. (2008:A-1589; 2006:A-3333)

\* S-881 Gill (D-34)

Removes appropriations for municipal library purposes from the four percent municipal property tax levy cap. (2006:S-2873)

\* S-882 Gill (D-34)

Regulates sales of certified copies of deeds or conveyances of real estate. (2006:S-2103)

\* S-883 Gill (D-34)

Consolidates nonpartisan municipal election procedures in Title 19 of Revised Statutes. (2006:S-495; 2004:S-1830)

\* S-884 Gill (D-34)

Gives membership in PERS Prosecutors Part to DLPS employees with title of assistant director, deputy director, assistant attorney general or deputy attorney general. (2006:S-504; 2004:S-2941)

\* S-885 Gill (D-34)

Establishes the Technology Business Incubator Program Supplemental Assistance Fund. (2006:S-955; 2004:S-569)

\* S-886 Gill (D-34)

Prohibits cellular telephone service providers from disclosing individual proprietary information without customer written consent. (2006:S-498; 2004:S-2425)

\* S-887 Gill (D-34)

Establishes the Administrative Law Judges Retirement System. (2006:S-1297; 2004:S-286)

\* S-888 Gill (D-34)

Requires health insurers to offer benefits for dose-intensive chemotherapy/bone marrow transplants and umbilical cord blood transplants for treatment of sickle cell anemia. (2006:S-490; 2004:S-982)

\* S-889 Gill (D-34)

Requires insurers which provide prescription drug benefits to cover costs of medications for treating sickle cell anemia. (2006:S-491; 2004:S-987)

\* S-890 Lance (R-23)

Increases statutory mandatory retirement age for justices, judges, administrative law judges, county prosecutors, and workers' compensation judges from 70 to 75. (2006:S-2125)

\* S-891 Lance (R-23)

Directs State public issuer of obligations to use competitive bidding process when investing proceeds from such obligations. (2006:S-974; 2004:S-1359)

\* S-892 Gill (D-34)

Requires health care providers to obtain informed consent from patients for use of certain reprocessed medical devices. (2006:S-2450)

\* S-893 Gill (D-34)

Requires certain persons seeking license to operate facility to provide magnetic resonance imaging services to undergo criminal history record background checks. (2006:S-950; 2004:S-1675)

\* S-894 Van Drew (D-1)

Authorizes former mayors and deputy mayors to solemnize marriages. (2006:A-2563; 2004:A-1942)

\* S-895 Van Drew (D-1)

Allows judge to admit evidence of prior sexual offenses in current sexual offense actions. (2006:A-1217; 2004:A-4094)

\* S-896 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes program concerning motorist directional signs for agricultural tourism establishment locations. (2006:A-4409)

\* S-897 Van Drew (D-1)

Concerns abandonment of private bridges that carry a State highway. (2006:A-1037; 2004:A-2876)

\* S-898 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires forfeiture of public office upon conviction of fourth degree crime or higher; disqualifies person from future office upon conviction of fourth degree crime or higher or conviction of crime involving dishonesty. (2006:A-2842)

\* S-899 Van Drew (D-1)

Permits the use of project labor agreements in certain public works projects other than projects involving buildings.

\* S-900 Van Drew (D-1)

Provides for representation of regions of the State on New Jersey Turnpike Authority. (2006:A-2910; 2004:A-416)

\* S-901 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires DOT and DEP to conduct study on options to alleviate congestion on Route 47. (2006:A-2569; 2004:A-1924)

\* S-902 Van Drew (D-1)

Directs DOT Commissioner to allocate Transportation Trust Fund monies for concept development and design of Route 55 extension. (2006:S-293; 2004:S-381)

\* S-903 Van Drew (D-1)

Creates "Task Force on the Extension of Route 55." (2006:A-2358; 2004:A-4527)

\* S-904 Allen (R-7); Connors, C. (R-9)

Provides additional mandatory fines and restitution for theft of flags or flag-holders from grave sites. (2006:S-1056; 2004:S-2701)

\* S-905 Singer (R-30); Bateman (R-16)

Expands Catastrophic Illness in Children Relief Fund Commission purpose to provide assistance for purchase of specialized vehicle to transport person over 21 years old with severe chronic disability.

\* S-906 Singer (R-30); Bateman (R-16)

Requires pharmacists to notify consumers when prescribed medications are substituted with generic drugs.

\* S-907 Van Drew (D-1)

Exempts certain physician-owned or operated ambulatory health care facilities from ambulatory care gross receipts assessment if facility is Medicaid or NJ Family Care provider. (2006:A-2087; 2004:A-3407)

\* S-908 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes "New Jersey Veterans' Hospital Task Force." (2006:A-1057; 2004:A-4453)

\* S-909 Van Drew (D-1)

Excludes veterans' entitlements from income for determination of PAAD eligibility. (2006:S-850; 2004:S-978)

\* S-910 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires certain safety measures at certain swimming pools. (2006:A-1040; 2004:A-3290)

\* S-911 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires all able-bodied Work First New Jersey recipients to perform community service. (2006:A-3073)

\* S-912 Van Drew (D-1)

The "New Jersey Health Insurance Exchange Act." (2006:A-3766)

\* S-913 Van Drew (D-1)

Supplemental appropriation of \$12,000,000 in capital funding to DOC for construction of 400-bed housing unit at Bayside State Prison. (2006:A-3064)

\* S-914 Van Drew (D-1)

Invalidates consumer contracts which require a waiver of right to file a consumer complaint. (2006:A-3103)

\* S-915 Van Drew (D-1)

Permits certain self-employed individuals to purchase small employer health benefits plans. (2006:A-2965)

\* S-916 Van Drew (D-1)

The Chloe Keiser Law; requires notice to consumers of availability of products to prevent tip-over accidents involving certain furniture or televisions.

\* S-917 Van Drew (D-1)

Concerns arbitration for certain non-teaching school staff. (2006:A-2753; 2004:A-2314)

\* S-918 Van Drew (D-1)

Permits the establishment of sick leave banks for school employees. (2006:A-2788; 2004:A-1871)

\* S-919 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires municipalities to exempt 100% disabled veterans from construction permit surcharge fees for improvements to promote living unit accessibility; appropriates \$20,000 for municipal reimbursements. (2006:A-4449)

\* S-920 Van Drew (D-1)

Revises criteria for eligibility to receive homestead property tax reimbursement. (2006:S-1835; 2004:A-3248)

\* S-921 Van Drew (D-1)

Permits municipalities to contract with animal and humane societies which engage in animal foster care. (2006:A-2093; 2004:A-2841)

\* S-922 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires that extended terms be imposed on defendants serving sentences of parole supervision for life who subsequently commit any crime of the first or second degree.

\* S-923 Van Drew (D-1)

Establishes arson investigation unit in Division of Fire Safety, Department of Community Affairs. (2006:A-1952; 2004:A-2974)

\* S-924 Van Drew (D-1)

Requires DEP to notify coastal municipalities of certain settlement discussions. (2006:A-3551)

\* S-925 Van Drew (D-1)
